



TREERING PICTURE UPLOADING INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1: Add Photo

- · Click on 'My Photos'
- · Click on 'Add Photos'



STEP 2: To Share or Not to Share

- Selecting 'Yes I want to share' enables them to be considered for the main shared yearbook pages *
- Select 'No Keep 'em private' to use for your own personalized pages

*Only upload school related pictures for sharing. All non-school related pictures will be removed from the shared folder.

STEP 3: Add to Class Folder
