

School Parking Lot Reminder

Independent Study Request for Pre-Determined Absences

An Independent study request can be made for minimum of 5 days and a maximum of 14 days. Students requesting 5 to 10 days of planned absence shall give 3 to 5 days notice prior to absence. Students requesting more than 10 days of planned absence shall contact the principal 5 to 10 days before the leave request initiates.

Dear Parent/Guardian/Caregiver:

Each year at our school, students in grades three through five participate in the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP). This assessment window is scheduled for April 11th through May 6th. Each student will take these assessments on their SRVUSD issued chromebook. These chromebooks have been updated with the latest web browser that supports the State of California tests. Students will take the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments for English language arts/literacy and mathematics. Fifth grade students will also take the California Science Test (CAST).

The Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments and the CAST are online tests that measure what your child has learned. The test results help our school understand what knowledge and skills students have mastered and which ones they may still need to learn. These scores allow parents and teachers to monitor student progress so we can help each student master the appropriate grade level academic standards. It's very important that each student takes the exam and tries their best. Overall, the CAASPP scores reflect on our students, schools and school district. You are an important part of your child's education. To help your child prepare for the test you can:

- Talk about the test with your child. Make sure they are not scared or anxious.
- Tell your child that they have learned the material in their classroom.
- Take advantage of the online practice tests if you so choose.
- Make sure your child gets a good night's sleep and a nutritious breakfast before testing.

If you have questions, please do not hesitate to reach out. Individual class testing schedules will be provided by your child's teacher as we get closer to the testing window.



CORPORATE MATCHING PROGRAM FAQ

How can I see if my employer can match my donation?

After you've made a pledge, you'll see a search box to search for your corporation. If they match, you will also be provided additional information from the search results to guide you on what you'll need to do next.

Where should my employer send the matching gift?

This should go directly to the school. Please contact your employer for more information on how they can send the matching gift to the school's coordinator based on their corporate policies.

Will my student(s) receive a prize for the matching gift?

Unfortunately, no. Students will not be earning prizes for your corporate matching gift.

How can I take advantage of Corporate matching gifts in my Booster campaign?
