Beginning on Monday, August 30th, COVID testing will be available at the SRVUSD Education Center Monday to Friday 11:30am to 5:30pm and Saturday 8am to 12pm.

To sign up, please follow the instructions posted on the district website.

(Pre-registration is required)

- There is no cost for this test.
- Tests area PCR nasal swab.
- Test samples are sent overnight to the lab.
- Results are available within 24 to 48 hours.
- Results will be sent via email or can check the status via the GVP app or website.

#### Crossing the Road

Please start a few minutes early from home to make it on time to school. Students should be in class by 8AM.

#### **Lunchroom News**

Families do not need to sign up or register to receive free meals at school.

Students attending schools on campus will have access to lunch at some schools, at no cost.

Students who are attending the Virtual Academy can also access meals at no cost at a school to be determined soon.

Kindergarteners will have access to lunch at no cost, along with all other students.

#### FORGOTTEN LUNCHES!

If you have a forgotten lunch, please drop it in the office NO LATER than 10:45am. Please clearly identify the lunch with first & last name, grade, and teacher before dropping it off.

Please remember this is only for the occasional emergency forgotten lunch and this courtesy is not meant for regular delivery. Students should bring their lunch with them each morning unless they plan to take the district lunch being offered in the MPR. Thank you.

#### School Safety

- 1. School supervision begins at 7:45am. Students should not be on the blacktop until 7:45am.
- 2. There are only 2 areas for pick up that have supervision.
  - a. Carpool for those who get picked up by car. Students wait by the front gate until their name is called.
  - b. Blacktop for those who walk home or are picked up in person.

Please do not ask your child to wait for you on a street corner or by the school sign. Both areas are not supervised. Accidents happen, and we need to be as safe as possible at all times.

#### **Medication at School**

A new 'Medication at School Form' needs to be turned in with any medications that will be kept on campus each school year. The 'Medication at School Form' (and the medication listed on the form) should be turned in to the school nurse.

Please note that students cannot be in possession of over-the-counter medications at any time.

#### Independent Study Request for Pre-Determined Absences

An Independent study request can be made for minimum of 5 days and a maximum of 14 days.

Students requesting 5 to 10 days of planned absence shall give 3 to 5 days notice prior to absence.

Students requesting more than 10 days of planned absence shall contact the principal 5 to 10 days before the leave request initiates.

Please contact your teacher or the school office to initiate a Independent Study Request.

"No student is entitled to a short-term independent study contract in excess of fourteen (14) instructional school days in a school year."

#### **Attendance Awareness Month**



#### Interesting Facts:

- Poor attendance can influence whether children read proficiently by the end of third grade or be held back.
- Research shows that missing 10 percent of the school, or about 18 days in most school districts, negatively affects a student's academic performance. That's just two days a month and that's known as chronic absence.
- By 6th grade, chronic absence becomes a leading indicator that a student will drop out of high school.
- When students improve their attendance rates, they improve their academic prospects and chances for graduating.

You can help your student by making sure that they arrive on time for school. Set a regular bedtime so your child is well rested. Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before. Avoid scheduling medical appointments or taking extended trips when school is in session.

Every school day is an important one!




#### 5th Grade Baby Photos Submission


- Login to Treering or go to <u>www.treering.com/validate</u> (school code 1016019833804511) to setup an account.
