SRVUSD will be offering the CogAT exam for all students new to the district who have never taken it and for 3rd and 4th grade students who have taken it once previously and would like another try. The CogAT exam is used for Gate identification and ATP eligibility. Register from October 19 to November 12 on the Gate Testing page of the district website. Late registrations will not be accepted. All families in grades 3-7 should have also received this email from the District with additional information.

To sign up, please follow the instructions posted on the district website.

(Pre-registration is required)

- There is no cost for this test.
- Tests area PCR nasal swab.
- Test samples are sent overnight to the lab.
- Results are available within 24 to 48 hours.
- Results will be sent via email or you can check the status via the GVP app or website.

Vaccination Status Update

The deadline to upload your vaccination status to Be A Mentor was <u>Friday</u>, October 15th.

If you haven't uploaded your proof of vaccination, you will not be able to volunteer at school.

Independent Study Request for Pre-Determined Absences

An Independent study request can be made for minimum of 5 days and a maximum of 14 days. Students requesting 5 to 10 days of planned absence shall give 3 to 5 days notice prior to absence. Students requesting more than 10 days of planned absence shall contact the principal 5 to 10 days before the leave request initiates.

Please contact your teacher or the school office to initiate a Independent Study Request.



Social Justice - 4-Part Education Series

For some parents, talking about race to a child can be unnerving. For others, it's a natural and necessary conversation from the beginning. Children begin to notice race as early as 6 months and begin to develop biases as young as 3. Parents must realize that when nothing is said about race, a lot is actually still being communicated. An important first step in teaching our children about how to be "color conscious" rather than "color blind" is to continue to deepen our own personal knowledge about race and to develop the skills to engage with them as well as others, in an effective way.



Students who want a Retake

A) If you already received your portrait package, please email us to put your child's name on the retake list to ensure their portrait is captured. Your full portrait package must be returned to the photographer on make up day to receive a new package at no additional cost. If your package is not returned on Picture day additional reprint fees may apply.

B) If you do not have a package to return but would like a retake photo, log into your child's proof link by scanning your QR code or use the link below (online code is the number on the QR code slip that came home on picture day), scroll to the bottom of the package options and select Retake Photo.

Please note the retake photo REPLACES the original photo.



STEP 1: Add Photo


