COVID testing is available at the SRVUSD Education Center Monday to Friday 11:30am to 5:30pm and Saturday 8am to 12pm.

 To sign up, please follow the instructions posted on the district website. (Pre-registration is required)

- There is no cost for this test.
- Tests area PCR nasal swab.
- Test samples are sent overnight to the lab.
- Results are available within 24 to 48 hours.
- Results will be sent via email or you can check the status via the GVP app or website.

Independent Study Request for Pre-Determined Absences

An Independent study request can be made for minimum of 5 days and a maximum of 14 days. Students requesting 5 to 10 days of planned absence shall give 3 to 5 days notice prior to absence. Students requesting more than 10 days of planned absence shall contact the principal 5 to 10 days before the leave request initiates.

Please contact your teacher or the school office to initiate a Independent Study Request.




There is NO left turn into the Hidden Hills Loop from Harcourt Way between 7:30 and 3:00

Upload your vaccination status to Be A Mentor in order to volunteer on campus.


If you haven't uploaded your proof of vaccination, you will not be able to volunteer at school.

Entries need to be in the School Office NO LATER than 9:00 AM on Wednesday, FEBRUARY 16, 2022.

ALL entries must have the following information on the REVERSE SIDE OF THE ART WORK:

STUDENT'S FIRST AND LAST NAME, GRADE LEVEL, TEACHER AND SCHOOL NAME

All entries will receive Certificates. Each 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place entry will receive a cash award and a ribbon presented at the Student Art Reception on Sunday, April 24, 2022. Letters with details on the art reception will be delivered to the winners' schools. Each 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place winner will move on to the Mt. Diablo District competition held March 10, 2022.


