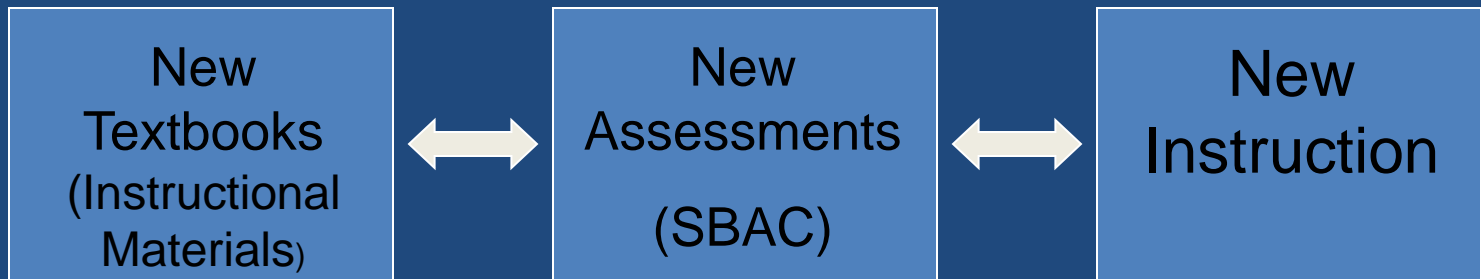

Phases of Implementation

over several years and in the context of a continuous learning process

- **2012-13: Awareness Phase** represents an introduction to the CCSS and the initial planning of implementation
- **2013-2014: Transition Phase** focuses on building foundational resources: new professional learning collaborations.
- **2014-2015: Implementation Phase** expands professional learning support, fully aligns curriculum, instruction, and assessments, & effectively integrates these elements.
